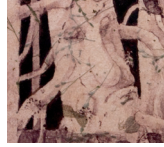


AUSTRALIAN SOCIETY OF MINIATURE ART (NSW) INC



The Australian Society of Miniature Art welcomes new members – painters, printmakers, sculptors – any medium is acceptable, as long as the perimeter of the work is 40 cm or less, and sculptures are no more than 15cm in any direction, including any plinth.

There are 2 intakes a year, on the second Friday of both April and October. **The work must arrive by the 1st of the relevant month.**

Submit four samples of your miniature work, which must be mounted (in white or off-white) but not necessarily framed. Post work in a returnable Postpak box to the Selection Convenor at PO Box 237, Willoughby 2068, NSW.

Don't forget to include return postage and the form below!

Exhibiting member fees: Annual subscription \$55, to be paid **after** notice of acceptance. Payment instructions will be provided.

Criteria for selection

A good miniature work (including abstract) should have the same qualities as any other artwork and will be judged against the following checklist:

1. DESIGN – have design principles been understood?
2. DRAUGHTMANSHIP – drawing of representational subjects should be accurate.
3. TECHNIQUE – is the medium handled consistently?
4. ORIGINALITY – looking for an individual approach or interpretation.
5. SIZE AND SCALE OF WORK – should reflect the spirit of miniaturisation.
6. FINE DETAIL AND/OR TEXTURES – which invite and reward close inspection.
7. Works should be consistent and of a high standard.
